As we strive for mastery of these words, include misspelled words from the previous unit's test, and words with which the student has trouble in other writing. Add only three to four words each week from the student's other writing and be sure he has drilled them daily on his flashcards. Give extra credit for the special challenge words, but if your child is frustrated by the challenge words, eliminate them from the test. Do not test on more than $15-20$ words each week. Have the student continue drilling using the DFR steps daily.
